HOW TO FACTORY RESET IPHONE AND DISABLE PASSCODE

To Turn off/Disable the passcode on iPhone or iPad.

- 1. Go to Settings (W), then do one of the following:
 - On an iPhone with Face ID: **Tap Face ID & Passcode**.
 - On an iPhone with a Home Button **Tap Touch ID & Passcode.**
- 2. Tap Turn Passcode Off.

Reset the passcode

if you can't remember your passcode, you can erase your iPhone with a computer or with recovery mode, then set a new passcode. See the Apple Support article <u>If you forgot the passcode on your iPhone, or your iPhone is disabled</u>.

How to Factory reset iPhone

Note: Before you factory reset your iPhone, ensure you back up your iPhone first so you can restore your data later.

1. Open the Settings app, scroll down and Tap General.



The "General Tab" on iPhone is highlighted above.

2. At the bottom of the General page, **Tap Transfer** and **Reset iPhone**.

4. Tap **Continue** to confirm you want to erase the iPhone.



5. On the next screen, enter your **passcode** if you have one already set.



6. Your iPhone will then create an iCloud backup. If you've already made a **backup or don't want to backup**, tap Skip **Backup** at the bottom.
